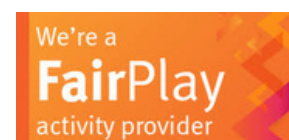
- Charged on first registration of financial year (1st July to 30th June)

TEAM DELEGATE - \$0 PER TEAM

- Nominate Team via yarrabilbatouch.com.au
- Send Link to players to register online



MINIMUM PLAYERS PER TEAM

- All teams must have a minimum of 8 players per team
- Teams below this number are removed from the draw
- Team U12 to Opens we recommend a minimum of 10 players per team



ONLY ALLOW REGISTERED PLAYERS TO PLAY

- Ensure no team members take the field that are not on the team sheet
- Teams that play unregistered players may forfeit competition points



HAVE ALL PLAYERS IN SAME UNIFORM

- All players must be in team uniform by Round 3 (singlet/shirt)
- A loss of 1 try per player for incorrect uniform
- *We encourage all teams to order their uniforms from our official apparel partner Struddys.*

BE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR TEAM

- All players abide by competition, state and national policies
- Players have mutual respect and behaviour in appropriate manner



ASSIT THE CLUB

- Encourage any players to become referees to help the sport of touch
- Report and facility concerns to the Competition Coordinator



GAME NIGHT

- Keep in contact with your team (competition updates, times etc)
- Bring a game ball to the field
- If you need to forfeit, notify the club before midday of competition

SENIOR PLAYER

- All participants must complete online registration before they are to take the field
- Referees are instructed not to commence game unless all participants have registered online and in correct uniform,
- Each Participant will be required to sign on/check-in for their game each week. This verifies your attendance for Insurance.
- Participants must play/attend five (5) games to participate in finals. It is the responsibility of the team delegate to check all qualifications.
- Support Team delegate with 'Duty Referee'
- Players requesting to change teams after registering to their current team must be done via the competition manager in writing and will be reviewed on a case by case scenario. No player can change teams after 50% of the competition has been complete.

JUNIOR PLAYERS

- Parent/Guardian Nominates Child online and agrees to TFA, QTF & YTA Declarations
- Parent/Guardian of participants must be present at the venue
- Parent/Guardian must abide by all club & sport policies

COACHES / TEAM DELEGATE

- Be present at the venue
- Must register online as a coach
- If any players in your team are under the age of 18, coaches must have a Qld Blue card or if a Teacher must have an 'exemption' card.

Minimum Age

- **Seniors** - For the **safety** of participants **we recommend the minimum age is turning 13 by 31st December the year of the season played.**
- **Juniors** - At request of the Competition Coordinator, parents must be able to provide birth certificate if needed
- **Juniors** - All players must not be over the age of the division nominated as of 31st December. E.g. If you are born in 2011 in the year 2024 you are turning 13, you must play U14 not U12.

Divisions

- **Mixed** Maximum male players on the field at any one time is 3
- **Mixed** Minimum number of male players on the field at any one time is 1.
- Any changes to split of players on the field will be advised by competition manager, this may also change finals of competition.
- To have a Junior Mixed Final there must be more than 3 mixed teams
- If a higher aged team needs to play down due to numbers, they can no play that age group finals.
- **Divisions** - Players are only allowed to play in 1 division of the registered competition as regrading process may take place.
- **Rep Players** - Junior Divisions can not have more than 4 rep players per team

Competition Points

Win = 3 - Loss = 1 - Draw = 2 - Bye = 3
Forfeit Loss = 0 - Forfeit Win = 3

Wet Weather

- We always have every intention to play. Always assume the games are on. Unless you see a social media post & receive a database notification email asap its off.
- If fields are open, and severe weather hits before or during, we will communicate, venue 1st, social media 2nd, email 3rd.

Insurance

- Any player injured at the venue is to report with game referee on the night, then refer to [Marsh Insurance Claim](#)

Forced Majeure

- If Yarrabilba Touch are unable to perform, in whole or part in any obligation under these regulations of a Force Majeure Event, Yarrabilba Touch is relieved of that obligation under these regulations to the extent, and the period it is unable to perform.
- In addition to this, Yarrabilba Touch has no obligation to refund to any individual or team any fees paid if it is unable to perform by reason of a Force Majeure Event.
- FORCE MAJEURE EVENT: for the purposes of these regulations a force majeure event includes but is not limited to any or all of the following:
 - Acts of God including flood, drought, earthquake, storm, cyclone, fire, explosion, epidemic; or
 - War or Act of Terrorism; or
 - Riot or civil disturbances; or
 - Permanent injunction of any duly constituted court of competent jurisdiction; or
 - Any fact, circumstance, matter or thing beyond the reasonable control of YTA/ TFA.

Blood Bin

- Any player with a bleeding cut or abrasion is to leave the field immediately and have the cut or abrasion cleaned and covered. At this time, any blood stained clothing must also be either cleaned or replaced.
- If the player does not leave the field immediately, the Referee will stop the game and ask the player to leave the field (normal substitution rules apply).
- Once the flow of blood has been stemmed, the cut or abrasion cleaned and covered and any blood stained clothing and equipment cleaned or replaced, the player may return to the field and continue play. If bleeding cannot be controlled and the wound securely covered, the player must not continue in the game

Forfeits & Late Starts

- If a team is not at the field at the time advertised of the game, the attending team is awarded winning the toss.
- If the offending team is not in attendance after the five (5) minutes has expired, the game will be deemed a forfeit win to the non offending team.
- If a team is late, one point may be awarded to the opposition team for every minute up to and including 5 points. Referee will determine allocated time.
- Any team that forfeits without notice more than once during the course of competition rounds WILL NOT be eligible for FINALS.

Mutual Respect Policy

- Referees will be instructed to enforce zero tolerance rules regarding referee abuse from players, coaching staff and spectators.
- Teams/Players/Coaches and spectators are bound by the Disciplinary Regulations Manual and 8th edition rules.
- Teams/players/spectators that consume or introduce alcohol at the venue outside the laws associated with liquor license requirements will be asked to leave.

Protest

- Protests will be heard and determined by the Sport Manager or SQBD President. The Competition Committee will collect relevant information, requests, score cards, score sheets, referee reports, livestream footage (if paid protest)
- Protests must be lodged in writing by Team Delegate within twenty (20) minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, to the Competition Coordinator or to an official designated by YTA.
- The protest will then be investigated and the Team Manager or their nominated representative will be notified of the decision.

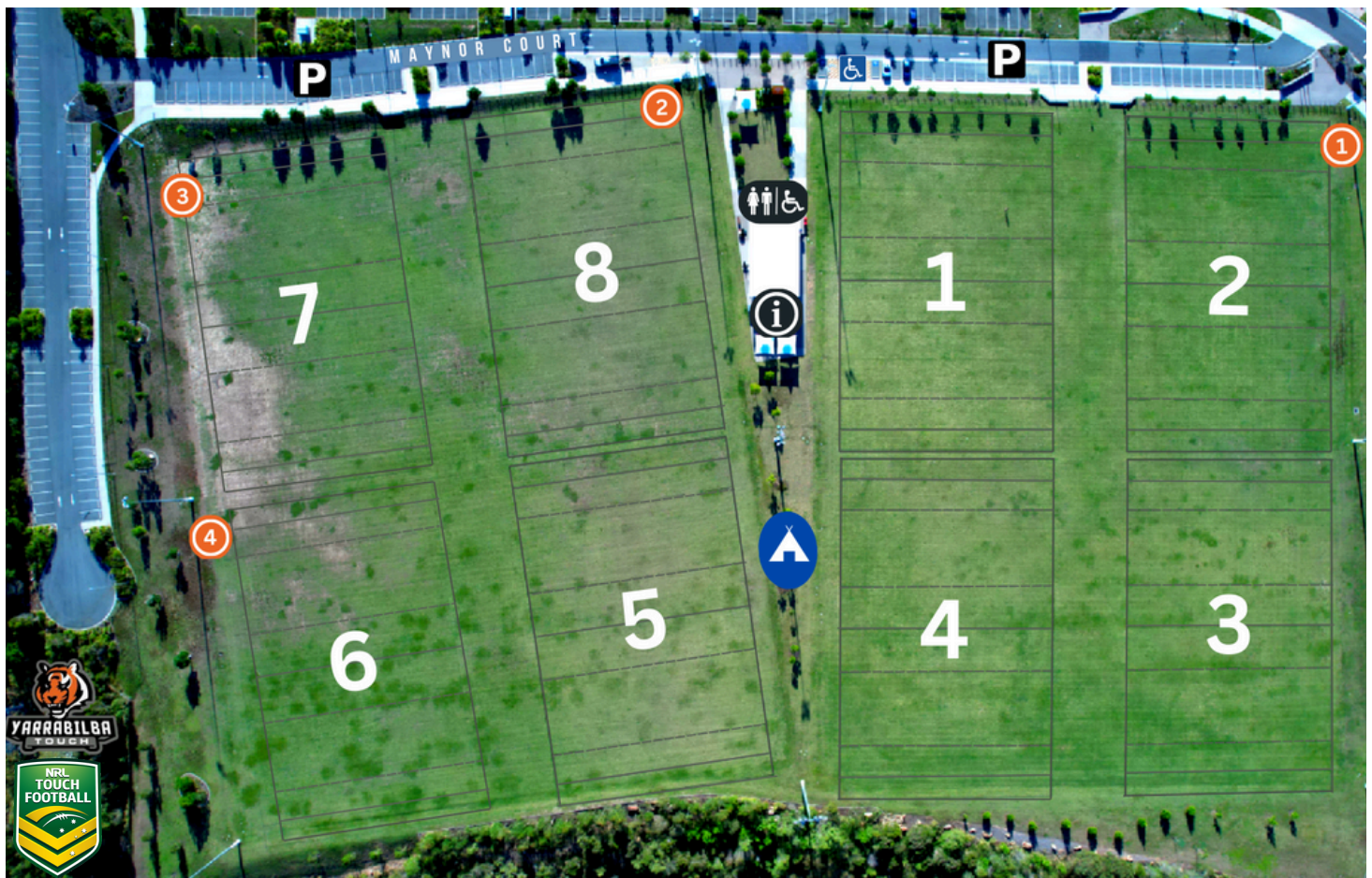
